Collective Bargaining Update

Under the new School Boards Collective Bargaining Act, 2014: ETFO Provincial is designated as the bargaining agent for centrally agreed upon items. Your Local bargaining team will still bargain for 'local' issues. This is a new process and ETFO is committed to keeping members as informed as possible. Please check the new ETFO collective bargaining website at www.etfocb.ca for regular updates.

ETFO was the first teacher bargaining affiliate to reach an agreement with the Provincial government and the Ontario Public School Boards Association (OPSBA) on what the central table negotiation items will encompass. The first central table bargaining sessions for ETFO teachers and occasional teachers will commence on January 21 and 22, 2015. Items that are not covered under the central table negotiations can be negotiated locally with respective school boards. Central and local negotiations may take place simultaneously if that is determined to be in the best interests of ETFO and it's Locals.

Your Local and it's Executive want to hear from you about collective bargaining issues that are important to you or questions you have about the bargaining process. Please feel free to contact or communicate with your Local in a variety of ways!

Elections for your 2015-16 Local Executive

The nomination form is enclosed with this mailing or found on the Local website under Elections. Your Local encourage all active members to consider taking an active role in the organization.

The nomination form can **only** be sent directly to the Elections Officer by **Canada Post** and must be received by the deadline of **4:00 pm Friday February 13th**, **2015**. Each candidate has the opportunity to include a candidate profile of up to 200 words with their nomination form. These profiles will be included with the mail-in ballot sent to all members in April. Executive candidates will have two minutes to address the members attending the General Meeting on Thursday February 19th, 2015 at Armour Heights PS.

2015 ETFO Annual Meeting Delegate Elections

The Annual Meeting of the Elementary Teachers' Federation will be held at the Westin Harbour Castle Hotel in Toronto from August 17th to the 20th. Elections for these delegate positions will take place at the Local's February 19th General Meeting. This year the Local is allotted 14 delegate positions at the Annual Meeting. The Constitution guarantees delegate status for both the President and First Vice-President.

If you are interested in running for one of the 12 open delegate positions, please email **scottmaudsley@ica.net** no later than **4:00 pm, Friday February 13th, 2015**. An email confirmation will be sent to you within 3 school days of receiving your request. All members in good standing who register by the deadline will have their name printed on the ballot. Before the vote, each delegate will have the opportunity to address the members for up to two minutes.

Motions to the 2015 ETFO Annual Meeting

The ETFO Annual Meeting provides Locals the opportunity to bring forward motions to influence the direction, goals and fiscal commitments of our Provincial body for the next year.

The first step in the process requires that any motion to the Annual Meeting be approved by the Local's membership at a General Meeting. If you have a motion you would like to bring forward, please submit it in writing to the Local by **4:00 pm Friday February 13th**, **2015**.

ETFO Standing Committees

The members of the ETFO Standing Committees are appointed provincially and meet during the school year to carry out their assigned tasks and make recommendations to the Executive. Here's your chance to become involved in your union by applying for an ETFO Standing Committee. Involvement with your union will provide you the opportunity to share your expertise and become a voice on Federation issues related to provincial policies, positions, programs, and initiatives.
