## TENTATIVE CENTRAL AGREEMENTS: ONLINE RATIFICATION VOTES

**Online Voting Period Begins: Thursday, April 23, 2020 - 5:30 pm (EST)**  
**Online Voting Period Ends: Monday, April 27, 2020 - 7:00 pm (EST)**

ETFO is holding two online ratification votes:

- One ratification vote for the **2019-2022 Teacher/Occasional Teacher (OT) Tentative Central Agreement**. Teacher and OT members are eligible to participate in this online ratification vote.
- One ratification vote for the **2019-2022 Education Worker Tentative Central Agreement**. DECE, ESP, PSP and education worker members are eligible to participate in this online ratification vote.

Voting results will be announced on Tuesday, April 28, 2020.

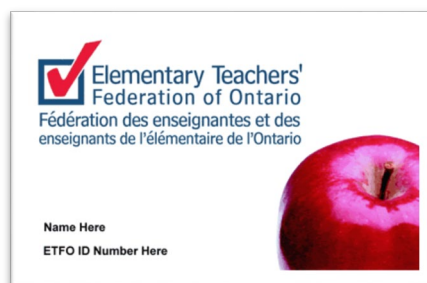
