On Wednesday, December 11, 2024, members received the 2022-2026 Tentative Central Agreement highlight document which outlines proposed strips that your team fought against and negotiated gains to improve your workplace conditions. The online meeting and vote to ratify the ETFO 2022-2026 Toronto OT Tentative Agreement will be on Thursday, January 16, 2025.

# 2025 ETFO Annual Meeting: Become a Delegate!

**The ETFO Annual Meeting** will be held in August 2025 in Toronto, with nearly a thousand members in attendance. The Toronto OT Local has 17 delegate spots. Delegates will discuss priorities, vote on constitutional motions, and approve the provincial budget.

At the **Local's Winter General Meeting on February 19, 2025**, the Toronto OT Local will elect **17 delegates** according to the Constitution.

The 17 spots include the elected President, 1st Vice-President, two Vice-Presidents, Treasurer, and Secretary, along with additional members chosen by secret ballot as per the **Local's Constitution**:

10.1.1 Delegates of the ETFO Toronto Occasional Teachers' Local to the ETFO Annual Meeting shall be:

(a) the elected President, 1st Vice-President, Vice-Presidents (2) Treasurer and Secretary (b) elected

from the membership, by secret ballot, at the February Local General Meeting to make up the complement of Local delegates for the ETFO Annual Meeting.




