Unity

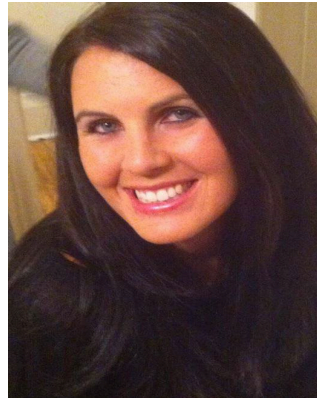
