My vision for our local includes fair health and dental benefits, paid sick days, professional development opportunities, safer work environments, enhanced transparency and communication within the union, increased member engagement, and a reduction in minimum days required to stay on the OT list.

In my ten-year teaching career as an OT/LTO, I've served on various committees and roles within ETFO - Toronto OT Local, including as Interim 2nd Vice President. I currently hold the position of full-time Health and Safety Inspector and serve as the OT Representative on the TDSB Joint H&S Committee. Additionally, I've chaired the Racialized Members Committee and the Political Action Committee, contributing as a grassroots organizer and facilitator for workshops focused on equity, social justice, and member empowerment.

Representing ETFO at the 2021 Ontario Federation of Labour's Biennial Convention and participating as a voting delegate at the ETFO Provincial Annual Meeting since 2020, I've actively advocated for all Ontario workers.
